#### **Hike Mount Arbel**

To the east side of the Kinneret stands the mountain of Arbel. The moderate uphill hike includes a beautiful view of the Kinneret and the surrounding region. It was here that Nitai Ha'arbeli mentioned in Pirkei Avos, once lived. In the face of its cliff is a four-tiered fortress which was used by the Jews as a hideout during the time of Hordus.
